- (c) Nomination application must be signed by a USBC Youth coach, or a USBC center/association manager.
- (d) Nominee must verify and sign application.
- (e) Nomination application must be accompanied by at least two letters of recommendation (teacher, coach, state or local USBC Center/Association manager, etc.) include address and phone numbers.
- (f) Nomination application must include all current league standing sheet(s).
