



Dear Association Officer or USBC Coach:

Enclosed is an application form (also available on-line at Michiganstateusbc.com). APPLICATION FOR OR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE SCHOLARSHIPS **DO NOT** AFFECT HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY.

Nominee shall be a current USBC Youth membership holder who is:

1. A High School Senior accepted by or
2. High School Graduate currently attending a college, accredited trade, or vocational school.

They shall be current active members of a Michigan State USBC certified Youth program. Applicant shall also be an amateur as defined by USBC Rule #400.

Each scholarship recipient has eight years following their high school graduation to use the funds and the funds may be used at any accredited college, university, or vocational school. All funds will be deposited at SMART.

In addition to the completed application, the following items must be submitted:

1. Current transcript of grades and ACT/SAT scores (if applicable)
2. At least two (2) letters of recommendation.
3. ALL current league standings.
4. Photograph of applicant.
5. Attach a separate sheet with the following information: Personal biography to include: Civic and Community activities, special awards/honors other than bowling, hobbies, interests, etc. List by year the USBC youth leagues you have bowled in, your plans or course of study, and why you feel you should be awarded this scholarship.

The deadline for filing applications is February 15. The selections will be made by the Scholarship Committee and the recipient(s) will be informed of their selection. The awards will be presented at the Michigan State USBC Annual Youth Banquet.
