

Parameters for evaluation of Grant Requests

For memberships under 1500 members based on the previous year's membership.

1. All requests for grants must be accompanied with a detailed description of the program to include location, time, dates, etc. Projected budget covering estimated income, itemized expenses, and outside contributions – i.e., bowling center participation, association management of the event.

REQUEST FOR PROMOTIONAL PROGRAMS OR EVENTS

- A. Only one request for a Program Grant per association per season will be awarded. A season begins August 1st and ends July 31st. Grants will be awarded for the current season only and will not carry forward to succeeding seasons.
- B. Grant program requests must be received at least six weeks prior to the start of the program.
- C. Requesting association must share the cost of the program.
- D. Grants requested by Michigan State USBC associations must have, as a goal, increased membership in the Michigan State USBC, promote interest in bowling and be measurable in hard numbers or reasonableness. Success of the program may be used by other Michigan State USBC associations without charge.
- E. Recognition must be given to the Michigan State USBC as a contributor to the program.
- F. Payment will be made after the program is completed. The request for payment must include copies of all bills, invoices etc. to support all expenses and/or income along with a report on the success or failure of the program. The request must be sent to the address on the Grant request form.

REQUEST FOR A GRANT FOR THE USBC CONVENTION

2. The National Convention for the current season the Michigan State USBC association will provide a grant of up to \$1000.00 for attendance at the USBC National Convention to any association with membership under 1500 members based on the previous year's membership. Payment consideration is listed on grant request for the National Convention. The amount of payment to be reimbursed to be determined by the Grant committee upon receipt of the Request for Reimbursement Form.

Association representatives to the convention must be a current member of the local association and an active bowling participant in a league in that association with a minimum
