Helpful HINTS for the State Tournaments

Check the website for your lane assignments.

Sub change? The form can be found on our website at <u>michiganstateusbc.com</u>. Go to 'forms' 'tournament forms' and scroll down to the tournament you are bowling. The form can be filled online and emailed to <u>office@michiganstateusbc.com</u>. Please be sure to use this form as it asks for all the information that we will need to make the change correctly.

If a sub change is being made onsite, please be there at least an hour early, with this form filled out if possible.

Averages? When you look at the lane assignments, if a bowler has an average of 230, check with your league secretary prior to bowling and bring in an individual record sheet/average sheet. Unfortunately, no adjustments to an average can be made without this form.

The delivery used in this tournament must be the same as that used when

the average was established.


