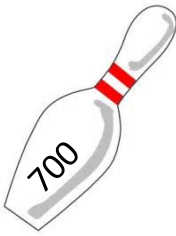

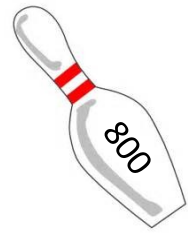

~ Scholarship Funds ~

In January of 2013, USBC went nationwide with an initiative requiring all scholarships to be awarded in points. Under the new system youth bowlers can ONLY be awarded **points** based on their bowling performance in youth leagues, tournaments and other events awarding scholarships. Event providers will deposit all scholarship money in the national SMART Bowling Scholarship Fund.

In order to use the scholarship money following high school graduation, bowlers in Michigan must submit an application to the Michigan Bowling Scholarship Fund along with verification (copy of transcript) that they have achieved a grade point average of 2.0 or greater. This form can be found on our website: michiganstateusbc.com

Once the academic requirement is verified and approved by the Michigan 'Gatekeeper', the youth bowler's accumulated points are converted to scholarship dollars and may be distributed by SMART for qualifying secondary education expenses.. The new procedures are approved by MHSAA, MBSF and USBC.

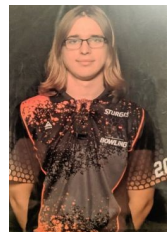
